

12 CEUs - HYBRID TEACHING SKILLS PROGRAM

Audience: Licensed Teachers

Hours: 120 Hours includes a project

Teachers prepare for Flexible Schools through this educational technology program that includes training in making and editing videos, managing online lessons, finding technology tools related to a particular subject area and grade level, discovering online collaboration strategies, and creating formative and summative assessments that are aligned to standards for grading online.

Participants learn to design curriculum for flipped, hybrid and blended learning models and can create lessons that can be taught online, face-to-face or both. Teachers are introduced to considerations for online safety and classroom management as well as video conferencing etiquette and boundaries. They will learn about selecting apps and technology tools for engaging and assessing learners. Participants are introduced to strategies for accommodating students with special needs in an online environment and explore how visuals can be used effectively in learning.



Upon successful completion of this program, participants should have an increased confidence in being able to **meet the needs of learners regardless of their location** and that could include:

- ✓ Setting up an LMS such as Google Classroom
- ✓ Planning a flexible lesson that can be taught online, or in the classroom, or both
- ✓ Creating rubrics and assessments for online learning
- ✓ Using video conferencing effectively
- ✓ Sharing and managing teaching videos
- ✓ Adding tasks and activities, quizzes and assignments into an LMS
- ✓ Setting up a gradebook and grading.



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
